Code of Ethics for exposition

- Registration and payment of fees for the exhibition must be received no later than **April 30, 2019**.
- You are responsible for installing and uninstalling your hardware.
- The location and / or arrangement of the tables and the panels may not be altered without prior permission from the Cultural Activities Director .
- No painting should enter the room before the allocation of places or be taken down before the specified end time of the exposition. The same goes for craftsmen and their equipment.
- Installation of paintings and handicraft equipment must be within the allocated hours.
- If there is a problem or suggestions, report them to those responsible for the exhibition.
- The paintings are installed on well-defined hooks.
- The frames must be inside the panels, top and sides.
- The paintings must be framed, with the exception of gallery type canvas.
- Managers reserve the right to request to remove a painting if it does not comply with standards.
- Paintings placed on the floor or otherwise will not be tolerated.
- The minimum price per square inch must be respected (50 cents per square inch) with the exception of very large paintings whose price is at the discretion of the exhibitor.
- Under no circumstances should you move the lights. If there is a problem, ask a manager. If your work requires special lighting you will need to provide it.
- The sale of cards of your work is accepted. The presentation should be about the size of a shoebox.
- Parking for artists / artisans is provided at the rear of the Centre Marcel-Tassé.
